Analyze his worldbuilding strategies, keeping in mind the long and often prophetic tradition of the dystopian novel.In what ways is Bradbury's world an exaggeration of our own? Consider the characters' hedonism, anti-intellectualism, and refusal to engage with painful events. The events of the novel are dramatic, but it is the depth and fervor of the characters' internal (and external) battles that makes the novel so rich.Analyze the sophisticated literary techniques and devices that make Fahrenheit 451 feel so vibrant, relevant, and alive.Bursting with symbolism, Fahrenheit 451 has a lot to say about grand ideas like death, pleasure, intellectualism, and censorship.
